The Cybersecurity program has experienced a slight decrease in retention compared to the previous academic year. To address this, the program has expanded its hybrid course options, which are in high demand. These hybrid settings are designed to help students build a solid foundational understanding of networking, essential for success in Cybersecurity. Currently, the classroom for seated classes accommodates only 18 students. However, a new lab under development will increase capacity to 20 students. Expanding seated options will allow instructors to deliver course material more effectively and foster stronger engagement with students, ultimately supporting improved retention rates.
