The medical assisting program has had an average retention rate of 67.9% for the past three years. This is slightly below the standard of 73.2%. However, it exceeds the threshold of 60% that is set by the Medical Assisting Education Review Board (MAERB). There were many reasons that we saw this dip in retention mainly due to the residual effects from COVID along with financial reasons were the driving factor in 2020-2021 and 2021-2022. We have seen an increase in retention for the 2022-2023 academic year.

The medical assisting program has a three-year average of 9.6 completers. After reviewing the reasons why many do not complete, we have found that the most consistent reason is due to financial reasons. Another reason several not complete is due to personal reasons and obligations. We have also found that students may not completely understand about the program and the time commitment needed to complete it. Some ways to increase completion numbers are to encourage students to apply for financial aid and other scholarship opportunities and to encourage all applicants to meet with the program director to understand the program time commitments.
